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Clinical Image

May –Thurner challenging case using endovascular procedures to treat chronic left vein occlusion.

Step by step:

1. After bilateral vein femoral access we did phlebography (**FIGURE A**).
2. Trying to cross the occlusion with special guide wires and micro catheter, pigtail to measure the length of the balloons and stent (**FIGURES B-D**).
3. After crossing the lesion we did progressive balloon angioplasty (**FIGURES E and F**).
4. Stent implantation (**FIGURE G**).
5. Phlebography showing the final result (**FIGURE H**) [1-8].



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
